

DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

God's Word is an integral and inseparable part of the educational process at Markoma.

Therefore the doctrines and philosophy of the Bible are evident in all that we do.

Your signature means that you understand our doctrinal position and agree for you child to be taught as we would teach our own children.

Please read carefully and sign where needed. Both parents must sign.

Section 1- God is a Person who has revealed Himself as a Trinity in unity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit - three Persons and yet but one God. (Deuteronomy 6:4; Matthew 28:19; I Corinthians 8:6)

Section 2- The Bible, including both the Old and New Testaments, is a divine revelation, the original autographs of which were verbally inspired by the Holy Spirit. (II Timothy 3:16; II Peter 1:21)

Section 3- Jesus Christ is the image of the invisible God, which is to say, He is Himself very God; He took upon Him our nature, being conceived by the Holy Ghost and born of the Virgin Mary; He died upon the cross as a substitutionary sacrifice for the sin of the world; He arose from the dead in the body in which he was crucified; He ascended into heaven in that body to judge the quick and the dead. (Colossians 1:15; Philippians 2:5-8; Matthew 1:18-25; I Peter 2:24,25; Luke 24; Hebrews 4:14-16; Acts 1:9-11; I Thessalonians 4:16-18; Matthew 25: 31-46; Revelation 11:15-17, 20:4-6, 11-15)

Section 4- Man was created in the image of God but fell into sin, and, in that sense, is lost; this is true of all men, except a man be born again he cannot see the kingdom of God. Salvation is by grace through faith in Christ who His own self bore our sins in His own body on the tree; the retribution of the wicked and unbelieving, and the reward of the righteous are everlasting; and as the reward is conscious, so is the retribution. (Genesis 1:26,27; Romans 3:10,23; John 3:3; Acts 13:38,39; 4:12; John 3:16; Matthew 25:46; II Corinthians 5:1; II Thessalonians 1:7-10)

Section 5- The Church is an elect company of believers baptized by the Holy Spirit into one body; its mission is to witness concerning its Head, Jesus Christ, preaching the Gospel among all nations; it will be caught up to meet the Lord in the air ere He appears to set up His kingdom. (Acts 2:41; 15:13-17; Ephesians 1:3-6; I Corinthians 12:12,13; Matthew 28:19,20; Acts 1:6-8; I Thessalonians 4:16-18)
